- ◆ Assist you in negotiating affordable repayments to other creditors.
- ◆ Advise you if any creditors refuse your offer, or if they decide to take further action.
- ◆ Help you prepare for a court hearing, such as repossession and in some cases represent you in court.
- ◆ Look at other options for dealing with your debts, e.g. bankruptcy.

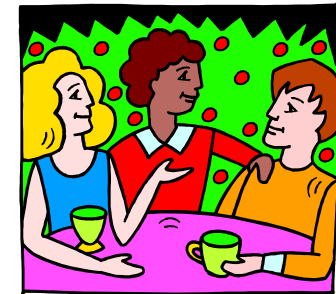
